







ELEPHANT SKIN

- -2.5 CM THICK
- -MORE WRINKLES ON AFRICAN ELEPHANTS.
- -WRINKLES INCREASES THE SURFACE AREA OF SKIN AND TRAPS WATER
- -TAKES LONG TO EVAPORATE AND HENCE COOLS THE BODY.

9 ELEPHANTS HAVE THEIR OWN SKIN CARE ROUTINE






MUD ACTS AS THEIR ORGANIC SUNSCREEN AND HELPS KEEP THEIR BODY COOL.



THEY SCRATCH


SCRATCHING HELPS REMOVE PARASITES LIKE TICKS AND FLEAS.

10 ELEPHANTS CAN'T JUMP, BUT !!!





THE BONES IN ELEPHANT LEGS ARE ALL POINTED DOWNWARDS AND THEY DON'T HAVE THE "SPRING" REQUIRED TO PUSH OFF THE GROUND, SO THEY CAN'T JUMP.



ASIAN ELEPHANTS RUN AT 25 KM/H (15 MPH) WHILE, AFRICAN ELEPHANTS CAN RUN AT 40 KM/H (25 MPH).
